





The decrease in Total Issuance and Average Issuance per Case in May 2022 is due to emergency allotment benefits ending in April 2022. The increase in Total Issuance and Average Issuance per Case in October 2022 is due to Cost-of-Living Adjustment.





### 1 Year Sparkline Population Trend




**Tuberculosis Control


