




- On 6/19/2023, DBME started receiving claims for replacement of stolen benefits as a result of electronic theft, known as EBT Skimming.

- EBT Skimming Monthly Preliminary Data: Between 11/1/2023 and 11/30/2023, 262 SNAP claims were approved for an issued amount of \$116,847.

- EBT Skimming Quarterly Final Data: In Q4 (July 2023 - September 2023), 1,982 SNAP claims were approved for an issued amount of \$792,685.




**Tuberculosis Control


